perked up after it was announced that significant investor Robert McEwan was exercising his 1.5 million \$0.70 warrants. EVR also announced a large addition to its Opinaca claim holdings. Results are still awaited from one Opinica drill program as well as from drilling at Cuanca (VMS targets) and Jobo Claro (gold targets) in the Dominican Republic. The RAB drilling at Jobo Claro has potential locate a surface gold resource similar to the one that kicked off the adjacent Pueblo Viejo mine. We continue to view EVR as one of the premier exploration stories, with two active gold projects that will attract a lot of market action with good results.
